Uploading Videos

Dear ISSRE 2021 Author,

Here are some simple instructions to help you create and upload your presentation videos to the ISSRE2021 online platform. If you haven't entered the MS Teams platform yet, please read the "Accessing the Conference Online Platform" document to guide you in the process.

1. Create the videos

You will have to create 2 videos:

- **Presentation** video, with 10-15 minutes. This video will be shared in the ISSRE2021 platform and available to ISSRE2021 participants and staff only.
- **Pitch** video, with 2-3 minutes. This video will not be made available to ISSRE2021 participants. It will only be used as a contingency plan to play during the live sessions.

While MS Stream supports many file formats, we suggest the use of **.mp4 (The format is: (paper name).mp4 or (Pitch-paper name). mp4).**

You are free to use any video editing tool you like (choice of the cover image, type of background, usage of pictures, etc.)

Please pay special attention to **sound quality**.

2. Go the Upload Channel

Open your **MS Teams** app (or website) and, in your **ISSRE2021 Pre-Conference** site:

1. Click on the **UPLOAD YOUR VIDEOS HERE** channel, and
2. Click on the **Files** tab

Then you should see the files folder.




3. Choose Your Session

1. All sessions need to upload videos are constructed in channel “UPLOAD YOUR VIDEOS HERE”.

2. **You must carefully check that the uploaded folder is the target session folder.**


Notice that the maximum size for each video is 1 GB, and only Video file types are allowed.

You must also give us consent to store the videos and make them available to the ISSRE2021 participants for visioning.



4. Done!

You should see your videos here:


How to Watch the Videos

Dear ISSRE 2021 Author,

After you complete the step (i.e. uploading videos) above, the last step also requires your cooperation to complete. If you have not registered for **Microsoft Stream** before, you can also not watch the video at any time in **Microsoft Teams**, after all the videos are published. But don't worry, a detailed description process will easily solve this problem. The process is as follows:


1. Show all Apps in the left menu bar

You will see all hidden apps, as follow:




2. Find and Click the Stream App


You should click the **Stream**:



If you did not have Stream account before, the following interface will be displayed:




Later, You should click the **Microsoft Stream**:




3. Log in with your Microsoft Teams account

When you complete step 2, you will be redirected to the Stream login interface, the account and password are the same as your Microsoft Teams account:




Later, You will complete the register of Microsoft Stream using your Microsoft Teams account.



4. Done!

When you have completed step 3, the registration has been successful. At this point, you can go back to Microsoft teams, and you can watch the presentation videos you are interested in at any time in all channels.
